Demo: Hinged bookstand, Matt Given

Matt has made quite a few of these hinged bookstands, created from one piece of wood. It involves precision marking, where the hinge will be cut and chiseled. Followed by precision resawing, which Matt does by hand, just so. He has developed the technique using a carpenter saw. The tolerances are tiny, when approaching the hinge area. Then the sawn surfaces will need to be sanded by hand.

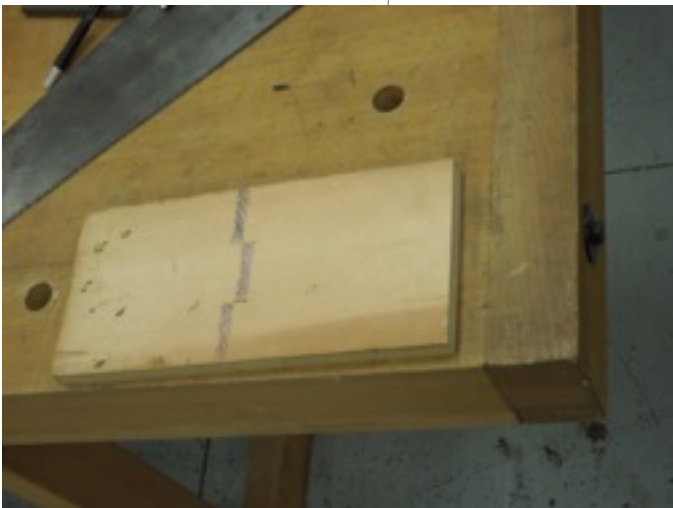

The finished product in poplar

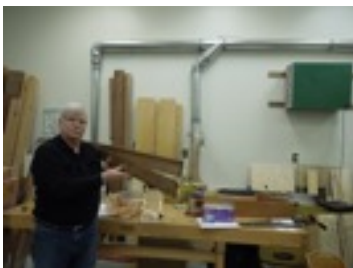
