### Lathe Meister: John Styer, also known as Drehmaschine Professor

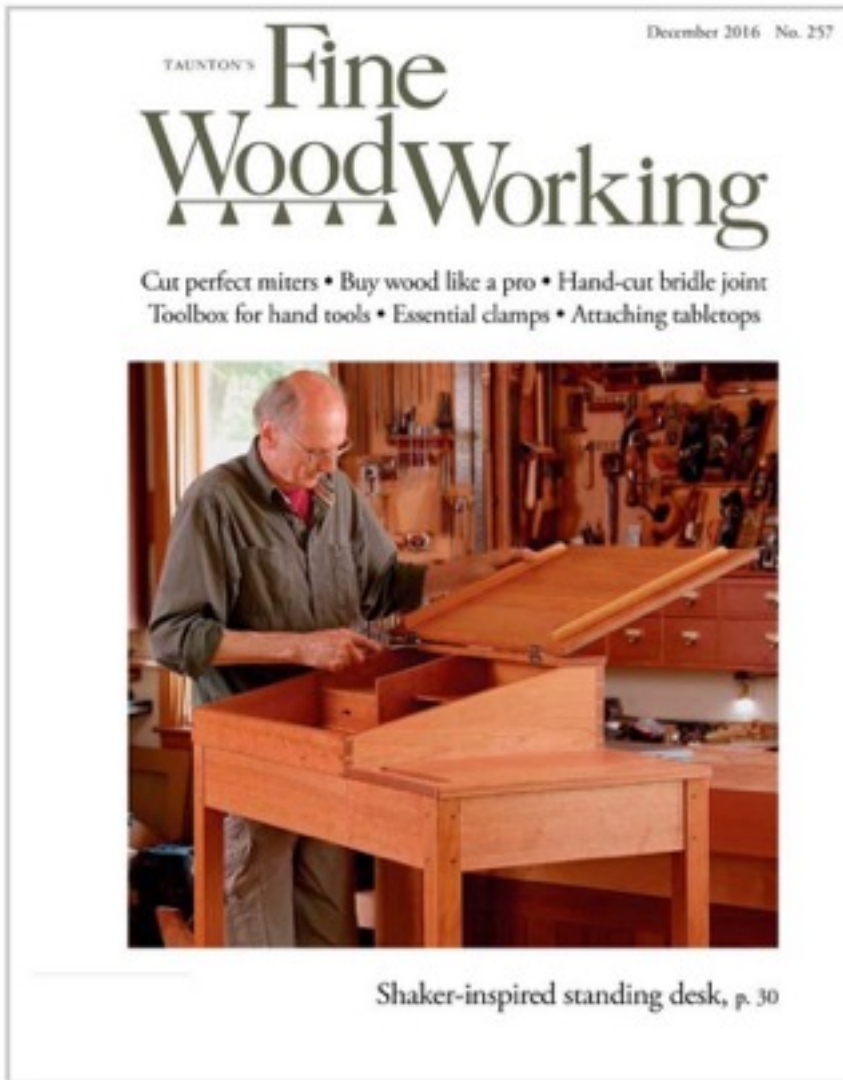
